What is the Local Option 206?

A crate engine designed to reduce the lead-time and cost to race by providing an out of the box, hand-built racing engine that can be 'built' as one moves up the Briggs & Stratton racing ladder.

Quick overview of the rules

Local 206 is a stock, out of the box gas WKA/IKF class. From carburetor to timing, this class is designed for simplicity and ease by remaining stock. For complete rules contact your sanctioning body.

Anatomy of the Local Option 206



- 1 Solid Foundation** – The heart of an Animal Racing Engine
- 2 Fuel Pump** – (simplifying getting started)
- 3 Seal** (factory sealed side cover)
- 4 Factory controlled piston pop-up** for unmatched consistency
- 5 Ground cam** for superior repeatability
- 6 PVL Ignition** (Rev Limited at 6,100 rpm with less than 1% variance) - Taking the variance of springs out of the equation.
- 7 Onboard rewind** – Simplicity at it's best.
- 8 Graph-oil head gasket** – Further reducing the cost of maintenance.



What it looks like to race the Local 206:

1st year: Run the engine and have fun.

2nd year: Racer has an option to advance in racing by purchasing an Animal ignition module and head gasket OR they can decide to rebuild off of a sealed short block (555517) or run what they campaigned their first year.

Resealing approach:

This engine is unique in that differs from all other sealing programs currently available. For starters, the durability and reliability of the package combined with a controlled 6,100 rpm PVL limiter make the need to access the bottom end of the engine unnecessary with simple maintenance.

- This program can be supported through anyone of our 180 Briggs & Stratton Racing Centers. There is no need for re-sealing agents.
- A new, sealed short block (555517) is available as a service item
- After the first year a racer can advance to the stock classes with the simple update of the ignition module and head gasket.

What a track and racer gets?

- A NEW price point to attract new and returning racers that feeds into your current stock program.
 - A lower price point for racers in year 2 and beyond
 - Resale value promoting future cost effective racing on the local level
 - Promotes long-term track health
- Simplified IKF/WKA rules
 - Sealed short block reduces tech time
